

CONSECRATE YOURSELVES Joshua 3:1-4:24

When God parted the Jordan River, it

demonstrated His power as a Conquering Warrior. The Ark of the Covenant, which symbolized God's divine presence, led the way for the Israelites (3:3-4). The moment the feet of the priests who bore the ark touched the brink of the raging waters the river was tamed (3:14-16). It testified to God's sovereignty over nature. Twelve men from each tribe were chosen to take

twelve stones from the river (3:12; 4:5). These stones were made into a memorial at Gilgal (4:19-20). The memorial was erected as a testimony for the next generation of Israelites on how God delivered the Promised Land into the hands of their ancestors (4:6-7, 21-23). It also served as a reminder for all people that God is mighty and must be feared (4:24). God did an amazing thing for the Israelites. His

presence gave them courage and confidence to conquer the Promised Land. He gave specific instructions they must obey for them to succeed (3:7-8; 4:1-2, 15). However, victory was assured only when they consecrate themselves before God (3:5). When you are in an unfamiliar territory, recognize God's presence in your midst. Remember who He is





"The LORD was with Joseph, and he became a successful man, and he was in the house of his Egyptian master. 3 His master saw that the LORD was with him and that the LORD caused all that he did to succeed in his hands" (Genesis 39:2-3 ESV).
