THE LORD YOUR GOD, HE IS GOD

Joshua 2:1-24

Joshua sent two men to spy out the land. Rahab, a Gentile prostitute who had faith in God, received the spies in her house. She risked hiding them from the king's men. (2:1-8). In her dialogue with the two spies, she declared the following about who God was:

- **A Promise-Keeping God:** "I know that the LORD has given you the land..." (2:9)
- **A Powerful God:** "For we have heard how the LORD dried up the water of the Red Sea before you when you came out of Egypt, and what you did to the two kings of the Amorites who were beyond the Jordan, to Sihon and Og, whom you devoted to destruction." (2:10)
- **A Sovereign God:** "And as soon as we heard it, our hearts melted, and there was no spirit left in any man because of you, for the LORD your God, he is God in the heavens above and on the earth beneath." (2:11) Before Rahab sent the spies away to safety, she pleaded them to spare her household from death when Israel attacks Jericho. The spies promised they will keep their word. And then instructed Rahab to tie a scarlet cord in her window as a sign that everyone inside their house will be preserved. (2:12-24) Rahab's story was a story of God's great mercy. She was a pagan who believed in God upon hearing what He had done for Israel. She was commended for her
