After Israel destroyed Jericho, Joshua pushed forward there was fear in the enemy's heart. But he was stunned when they were defeated! Joshua mourned the loss and blamed God. (7:1-9)

God commanded Joshua to rise and revealed the reason for their defeat: Israel suffered the consequence of one man's sin. Unless they got rid of the devoted things, victory would elude them because God's presence would not be in their midst. (7:10-13) In His great mercy, God gave specific instructions for

Israel to be redeemed. All the tribes needed to consecrate themselves. They had to appear before Joshua by tribe, clans, households, and man by man. The one found to have taken the devoted things was meted a severe punishment to turn away God's burning anger. (7:14-15) The hidden sin of Achan was exposed by God. He and

his entire household were stoned and burned to death A great heap of stone was raised over Achan. The monument served as a severe warning of God's wrath against willful disobedience. (7:16-25) God's people must tremble at His wrath. He deals with

deliberate, hidden sin decisively. He will not let any sin go unpunished. You may hide it from others, but never from God. Eventually, all sin will be exposed by God. Come clean before God—confess your sins, repent, and return to Him. reminders

After they marched around Jericho seven times on the seventh day, Joshua ordered the people to shout. At once the wall of Jericho fell down. (6:1-16) The entire city of Jericho and all that was within it

were destroyed as devotion to the Lord. Only Rahab

the prostitute and all who were with her in her house were spared because of what she did for the two Israelite spies. However, all silver, gold, and every vessel of bronze and iron were taken into the treasury of the Lord. Jericho became a symbol of ultimate apostasy and immorality that Joshua pronounced a curse to whoever would rebuild the city. (6:17-27; cf. Deuteronomy 20:16-18) Whatever battle you face in life, be confident that God, our Mighty Warrior, will fight for you! Sometimes, His methods are beyond human comprehension. But all you need to do is fully surrender your all to Him and do whatever He says. Strive to walk in holiness and He will surely guide your
