Jesus Our Healer Luke 17:11-19

As you all know by now, Santa Rosa is not exempted from COVID-19. When I recorded my message last week it was March 14, 4:00pm there still were no reported case in Santa Rosa. But early morning of Sunday, March 15, I saw in the news that there's already a case in Santa Rosa. It's a sad reality. It seems that we are helpless with COVID-19 but one thing is for use, our hope is in Christ.

We will have a break in our sermon series based on the book of Joshua and we will take a closer look at the passage in Luke about the meeting of Jesus and the ten lepers. The Lord Jesus met the ten lepers as He was on his way to Jerusalem. They cried to Jesus for mercy. They were helpless in their situation. They were outcast of the society. In our language today, they were quarantined on a certain place and they were not allowed to mingle with other people (vv. 11–13).

Jesus showed His mercy on them and they were healed (v. 14). One of the lepers went back to Jesus and gave thanks. He was a Samaritan. He was not only an outcast because of his sickness but also because of who he was. And Jesus pronouncement gave us a hint that the Samaritan leper did not only received physical healing but spiritual healing as well (v. 16).

Our country needs healing from COVID-19 but it's not just the physical healing that this country needs, more important is the spiritual healing. Our hope is in Jesus Christ. We are helpless but we have hope in Jesus. He is our healer. He is miracle-worker. Jesus can heal this land.

What is more important is the spiritual healing. There is only one name given under heaven by which man can be saved and His name is Jesus Christ (Acts 4:12). He alone can save us from the penalty, power, and presence of sin. The only means that the Scripture has given us to receive the gift of salvation is through faith. It is not through works but through faith in Jesus Christ (Ephesians 2:8–9). The object of our faith is Jesus Christ. We place our trust and confidence in Christ and Christ alone.

Let us put our trust in Jesus, our healer! He can heal our land physically and spiritually. clean before God and He will surely direct your every step towards victory!
